Lieutenant Colonel of the Army, a Helicopter Pilot, he is a Senior Analyst at the Spanish Institute of Strategic Studies (IEEE), CESEDEN, where he is focused on issues related to European Union strategy on foreign and security policy, and Asia in the fields of security and defence.

He holds a Degree in Law and Economy, a Master's Degree (MD) in Diplomacy and International Relations, a MD in EU Institutions, and a BA in Economic Intelligence. Mr. Márquez has developed his professional activity during the last years in political life being a Congressman for the Popular Party in the 9th and 10th legislatures in the Congress of Deputies, centering his parliamentary activity in the areas of security and

international affairs. He became Spokesman in the Internal Committee and an active member in the Committee on Foreign Affairs.

He was Minister for Economic Affairs and Human Resources of the Regional Government of the Autonomous City of Ceuta and Vicepresident of the Port Authority of Ceuta.

He has numerous publications to his name, including “UN 1540 resolution, the role of national Parliaments” and “Economic lessons from the Yugoslav crisis”.
